


Parts List - Driver Side Wall

Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Identify the TempShield Panels and their respective vehicle surfaces as shown below. For additional guidance, please refer to the sheet layouts found in the last three pages of this document.

Step 2: Wipe the identified surfaces of the vehicle clean, dry, free of dust, debris, or any foreign materials before adhering the TempShield panels. Remove TempShield panels off the sheet layouts using a utility knife.

Step 3: Peel off the protective layer of the TempShield and place its adhesive side to the Van body. For ease of installation, install the outside panels first in pocketed areas. E.g. install D14-C/D before D14-A/B.




Figure 1: "Driver side TempShield Installed" This view is from Inside of Van-Viewing from Passenger side





Figure 2: "Passenger side TempShield Installed" This view is from Inside of Van-Viewing from Driver side




"Celling TempShield Installed" This view is from Inside of Van


Parts List – Sliding Door





Passenger Side Sliding Door TempShield




Rear Door TempShield




